



Breath Test Operator Renewal Course #951

A Breath Test Operator permit is maintained through successful completion of continuing education. Breath Test Operators must satisfy continuing education requirements in order to maintain valid permits; and continuing education requires successful completion of the applicable Commission-approved Renewal Course by June 30 following the fourth permit anniversary date, and during each subsequent four-year cycle.

If a breath test operator does not attend the Breath Test Operator Renewal Course within their continuing education cycle, once the cycle is up, they must not administer breath tests until they attend and successfully complete a Breath Test Operator Renewal Course.

The requirements must be followed if a breath test operator does not successfully complete a renewal course: If a breath test operator fails a Breath Test Operator Renewal Course, he/she shall not perform the duties.
