If you end up in the water, in full duty gear, by being pushed, on accident, or by choice **do you know what to do?** What is the best decision? Swimming away from the threat, using deadly force, or some other option? **Don't wait for it happen, have a plan!** You work in an area surrounded by a lot water; natural and man-made. This training will expose you to real life scenarios and your best options depending on the situation. Officers attending will become familiar with lifesaving skills and officer survival in water. **All skill levels welcome.**

Required training gear:

- Training shirt, BDU pants, and work shoes with a swimsuit underneath clothing. Water shoes are optional.
- Training vests and duty belts will be provided.
- Students should pack their lunch; bring plenty of water or sports drinks, a towel and change of clothes.
